Burlington County, in cooperation with the Delaware Valley Regional Planning Commission (DVRPC), is conducting a Local Concept Development (LCD) study to determine appropriate improvements to CR 614 (Tom Brown Road), CR 603 (Riverton Road), and New Albany Road. The project goals are to enhance safety and improve operations for all modes of transportation.

This initial Public Information Center will be held online to introduce the LCD Study, present project information, discuss existing conditions, and obtain stakeholders' input on community interests and issues to develop a draft Purpose and Need Statement, which defines and justifies the primary transportation need to be addressed. It also sets the stage for consideration of the alternatives and is a fundamental requirement in the development of a project that will require future NEPA documentation.
